JOB TITLE: Deli Lead

SUMMARY/OBJECTIVE: Deli Lead is responsible for managing department inventory, in-stock position, pricing integrity, merchandising, labor, and other operational processes of the Deli Department to LDF Country Market standards. Deli Lead must follow the sales and production planning standards and will ensure that the deli department achieves the standards of performance as outlined in their work plan.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Specific duties include, but are not limited, to the following:

- Supervise associates in various duties such as cooking, serving, packaging, food rotation, hold dates, hold times, sanitation and deep cleans.
- Manage daily activities of associates and inventory to improve sales performance and improve efficiencies.
- Design and implement a PAR inventory system and rotation management.
- Assist in preparation of inventory, labor costs and sales budgets.
- Schedule and assign work for associates on daily basis.
- Assist in hiring of deli department associates.
- Train and follow up with associates on proper ServSafe standards and following health codes
- Ensure associates follow company policies and operational procedures.
- Ensure that products are properly labeled with prices and dates.
- Monitor and maintain stock inventory levels to avoid over and under stock problems.
- Ensure that department is maintained neat, clean and safe.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

EXPECTATIONS/ABILITIES:

- Must demonstrate a higher standard of customer service.
- Must demonstrate multi-tasking in a fast pace multi-faceted operation.
- Operate all food preparation machines and equipment.
- Analyze profit and loss statements and recommend improvements to meet department goals.
- Ensure that the deli department is maintained neat, clean, staffed, sanitized and positive service orientated.
- Provide training to staff on sales goals, cost controls, food handling and sanitation.
- Develop sales promotion programs.
- Interact with customers, and respond to queries, while solving problems related to sales and dissatisfied service.



- Receive, unload and stock inventory by following FIFO inventory system.
- Menu planning and ongoing assessment of menus, adjusting choices as needed.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY: This position has direct supervisory responsibilities of all deli department staff.

WORK ENVIRONMENT: This job operates in a fast pace multi-faceted operation environment. This role routinely operates all food preparation machines and equipment.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk and hear. This is a largely sedentary role; however some filing is required. This would require the ability to lift files, open filing cabinets, and bend or stand as necessary.

POSITION TYPE/EXPECTED HOURS OF WORK: This is a full-time position. Occasional evening, weekend and holiday work may be required as job duties demand.

TRAVEL: Little to no travel is expected for this position.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: High school diploma or equivalent is required. Two years in a Deli, buffet or short order service capacity with at least 6 months in a supervisory capacity is required. ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certification is required within 30 days of employment.
